Set deep in the Shikoku Mountains of Tokushima Prefecture, this scenic area is known for its dramatic mountain valleys, thatched roof farmhouses, and historic vine bridges. On this day trip we'll take a private coach to see, taste, and experience the best this spectacular valley has to offer!



MAKE IYA SOBA

This region is famous for its soba noodles. Our first stop is for a two-hour soba-making lesson from locals.

were originally 13 of these vine bridges spanning the valley. We'll go to the main bridge, 14 metres above the valley floor for a nerve-wracking walk across one of Japan's most important cultural artefacts (¥550 to cross the bridge).

TAKE ON FOREST ADVENTURE

We'll put on harnesses and get roped up for an adventure in the trees. We'll traverse rope bridges in the forest canopy and take on the 360 metre zip line down the canon. A truly unforgettable experience!
